Send us your project, participation is open to all photographers, curators, and collectives of any age. The winning project will become a photo book published by Skinnerboox that will be presented during the opening days of the festival. Entries will be accepted until **16 January 2023 at 11 pm CEST**.

**Entry fee:** 10€

**Deadline:** 16 January 2023 at 11pm CEST

The projects received will be assessed by a jury composed of Milo Montelli, Tim Clark and Chiara Capodici

### **Prize**

The winning project will be published by Skinnerboox and presented during the opening days of the festival 2023 (28 29-30 April). The book will be printed with a print run of 500 copies.

### **Required material**

- the project must be sent in pdf format (maximum size 10mb), it does not have to be already paginated, sequences of images can also be sent
- pdf form with your data
- images and privacy consent

### **To enter**

- Pay the entry fee by PayPal on the website of Fotografia Europea.



- Send your PDF file, the form with all your details, the PayPal receipt and the Privacy Notice, duly filled in and signed, via Wetransfer (don't send a link) to [call@fotografiaeuropea.it](mailto:call@fotografiaeuropea.it)

### Form and regulations

1. Each artist can submit one book project. Any additional submission will not be considered.
2. The submitted project does not necessarily have to be already edited and designed. However, editing and design will be agreed with the publisher.
3. We will give priority to completely unpublished books, but also self-published books printed in less than 100 copies can be submitted.
4. Photobooks that have already been published with a publisher will not be Considered
5. Projects in line with the theme of Fotografia Europea 2023 "EUROPE MATTERS" will be judged with extra points.
6. The Jury is composed by: Milo Montelli ( founder Skinnerboox), Tim Clark (Fotografia Europea Artistic direction) e Chiara Capodici (Leporello photobooks et al.)
7. The Jury will meet at the beginning of February to select a shortlist of 5/10 titles and the winner of the Prize, who will be announced by the end of February 2023.
8. The Winner will have his/her book published (in an edition of at least 500 copies) and launched at Fotografia Europea Opening Days 2022 (28-29-30 April).
9. The Winner will be a guest of the Festival during the opening days.
10. In addition to the publication, the winner will receive 30 copies of the book.
